WHAT IS FLEXN?

Characterized by pausing, snapping, gliding, bone breaking, hat tricks, animation, and contortion, Flexn is a form of street dance that has evolved from the Jamaican bruk-up found in dance halls and reggae clubs in Brooklyn.

HOW TO APPLY FOR THE D.R.E.A.M. RING DANCE COMPETITION

- Open to dancers ages 12 and older
- All street dance styles are accepted
- Download and complete the Application Form.
- Create a video of your dancing (maximum 3 minutes).
- If you are applying as a "two-man" or group, make sure you are all in the video. Those who submit a solo performance will be considered for tag-team. See descriptions below.
- Upload video to YouTube or Vimeo.
- Email the Application Form, video URL link, and password to dreamringxperience@gmail.com
- In the email, include your name, partner's name (two-man), contact information (email and phone), style of dance, social media links, and if you are signing up for tag-team or two-man performance.
- Deadline for all applications is 10pm Friday, June 3, 2016.

TAG-TEAM performances consist of groups of quartets whose goal is to choreograph duets, within the group, that highlight each other's styles and narratives individually and collectively.

TWO-MAN performances are duets that showcase artists with the same or complementary styles with the goal to choreograph a body of work that exemplifies those styles through a singular narrative.
